

'A Star Is Born!' Audition Time

Dear Parents

I announced to the children before Christmas that we will be having our talent show "A Star is Born!" later this month. Anyone who likes *singing or dancing* (or both), is invited to come for an audition in the week beginning Monday 13th January.

If your child would like to audition, please complete the "Application Form" attached and return it to the **school office no later than 3.30pm on Friday 10th January**. **Applications received after this date will only be accepted if the child was absent from school on that Friday.**

If your child wants to audition as part of a group, then all the application forms for each person in the group must be stapled together and given to the office.

The show for children in Reception, Years 1, 2 and 3 takes place at 7pm - 9pm on Thursday 30th January and the show for Years 4, 5 and 6 is Friday 31st January at 7pm - 10.30pm. The show for older children is a competition. If you know you cannot make the date, please do not let your child audition. If you have siblings who want to perform together and are younger than Year 4, they will go into the Thursday night show.

Children may audition for a MAXIMUM OF 3 acts eg a solo dance/song and also as a member of a group. The act must include singing and/or dancing (no comedy/magic!).

You must complete one application form per child for each act. Spare application forms will be in the school office.

Children must either bring music into school (ipod etc to be left in the school office in the morning, or CDs taken to class) or **email music to Mrs Tottle-Nugent on h.tottle-nugent@st-monicas.enfield.sch.uk** Vocal performances will need a backing track with no voice on it which parents will need to sort out. Bring dance shoes or props if needed (but no costumes etc). Each act will have **one minute** to impress the judges for their audition. If your child is absent on the day of the auditions, another day and time will be rearranged. The judges are Karen Borley and me with vocal support from Ms Phillips.

Children who have got through to the show will get a letter by Wednesday 22nd January. Tickets for the children involved will then be sold (£5 per adult and £2 per child). Children who have not got through will also get a letter. Apologies in advance for any disappointments. Money for tickets can be paid after 31st January (pay day!)

Remember to please complete the application form attached and return to the school office **NO LATER THAN FRIDAY 10th JANUARY**.
