- 1) Alisha went on a shopping spree and bought 4 pairs of shoes. Each pair cost £25. How much did she spend?



- 2) If Riley eats 5 treats a day, how many does he eat over 34 days?



- 3) Christine needs to order some new whiteboard pens. She orders 6 boxes. Each box contains 24 pens. How many pens are ordered?

- 4) Karen wants to replace the school's footballs. Each football costs £9 and she wants to order 134. How much will they cost?



- 5) Miss McCarron buys a jar full of 126 sweets. She wants to get enough sweets to last her all year, so she buys another 4 jars. How many sweets are there in all 5 jars?



- 6) Brandon goes to play football 7 times in a month. How many times does he play football over 24 months?

- 7) Jack watches 4 TV programmes every morning and 2 every evening. How many programmes does he watch over 365 days?



- 8) Lewis takes a train to London. Each train carriage can carry 66 passengers. The train has 9 carriages. What is the total number of passengers that the train can carry?



- 9) Mrs Sesto is counting the dinner money. Three classes have sent £18. They send the same amount of money for 2 days. How much money is sent to the office altogether?

- 10) Mrs Koumpi buys 5 books for each class in the school 3 times a year. There are 14 classes in St Monica's. How many books does she buy over one school year?
