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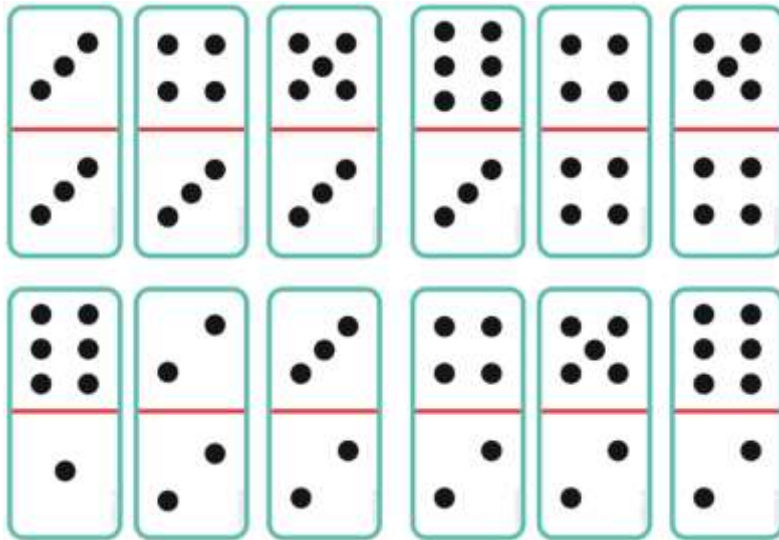


2. Complete the [Tricky Words Handwriting pdf](#) on our website.

Maths

Focus: **Doubling** (Use real objects when first demonstrating how to double. E.g. Take 3 pieces of pasta from a pile and ask your child to double the amount. How many are there altogether? Explain that 3 and 3 makes 6 (or $3 + 3 = 6$).

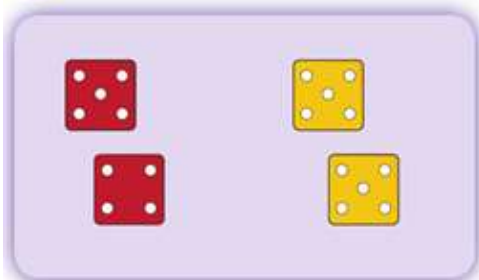

ASK

- Question 1: What is a double? Where can you see a double?
- Question 1: How do you know it is a double? Why does the other set not represent a double?
- Question 1: What do you notice about the spots on the dice? Where have you seen this pattern before?
- Question 2: How many balloons are in each group?
- Question 2: What is the same about the groups? What is different about the groups?
- Question 2: Is it still a double if the balloons are different colours?
- Question 2: How many balloons are there altogether? How did you work it out?
