


## AppShed Week 2


This week we continue to learn how the apps are created and how to create tabs.

First, login to the AppShed site and choose app builder.

Once in you will then be able to go to the appshed academy



We are using the basics button again and going to chapter 2 and 3 this week.




This week you should be able to create your app icon and home page from chapter 2.


Start by clicking on the + button at the bottom of the device on screen.



You will then enter the setup page.



To title the app go in to the settings button and this screen appears



Food4All


Find lots of recipes to suit all tastes, with simple amendments for those fussier eaters. Recipes recommendations from the list of ingredients you have available.

Remember to call your food, or sport related app by the name we were working on in class and give a short overview of it in the description. See above as an example (red text).

If you come out of your app creating you will note that the app icon appears on the device.




Click on it and accept open app to continue working on it.



Next, make the first tab a home tab as this will eventually connect you to the other features. If you are able to create all of the tabs needed ready for next week that will be excellent.

Remember keep the tab name simple and descriptive and less than 12 characters eg recipes, ingredients, swaps, favourites



Click on the tab menu as directed in the videos. You will have a maximum of 5 tabs.
