

MUSIC LESSONS FOR SEPTEMBER 2020

Dear Parents and Carers,

I've just received a message from EMS (Enfield Music Service) to say that booking for lessons for September is now available. This is the link <https://traded.enfield.gov.uk/musicstore>

At the present moment it is not possible to say when/if lessons will resume face to face in school, so lessons are being booked for online tuition. These lessons are obviously individual, though if your child was having a lesson in school as a pair, there is an option to have fortnightly individual online lessons to reduce the cost.

I'm concerned to see that there is a limited availability of instruments - violin, cello, flute, clarinet, for example are only available for existing students. This will change when face to face lessons can begin again.

I would strongly recommend:-

- (1) If you have a preference for an instrument not on offer to wait as I think there will be availability soon - and I am speaking to our regular tutors.
- (2) If your child is in Years 2 and 3, don't opt for recorder as we teach it in Year 3 (and as this year's Year 3 missed out, I plan to teach it in Year 4).
- (3) Do contact me for advice, I'm always happy to help. We need to build up our instrumentalists in school, and choosing a less common instrument is often advantageous in the future.
