Please find below some suggestions for work that you could do over the summer holidays that will help you prepare for Year 6. We know that many of you and your parents/carers will be looking forward to the summer holiday and a break from any requirement to be involved in home-schooling, so the work is not a requirement, but simply a few suggestions.

English

- Write a recount of an event. We are aware that holidays will be a lot different this year, so it could simply be a recount of an activity that you did at home.

- How many of the Year 5 and 6 words do you know already? Perhaps you could aim to learn 5 new ones every week in preparation for Year 6 (PDF will be available on Class Dojo on Friday 17th July).
- Read daily and write a review of one of the books that you have read.
- Read the comprehension challenge cards and answer the questions (PDF will be available on Class Dojo on Friday 17th July).

Maths

- Keep practising your times tables by regularly logging onto TT Rockstars.
- Recap on your addition, subtraction, division and multiplication skills by doing the Calculations Review sheet (PDF will be available on Class Dojo on Friday 17th July).
