"...at a meeting I attended yesterday with public health, Enfield has currently one of the lowest incidence of rates of COVID infections in the country (142nd out of 152 local authorities with a weekly infection rate of 5.69 per 100,000 people)."

As previously advised, term will start on Monday 7th September for Years 1-6 and children are expected to wear full school uniform. Children must come to school in their PE kit on their PE day – each class's day will be advised next week.
