<b>Reading</b>	Read daily! As mentioned previously, the 'Oxford Owl' website has plenty of free Ebooks for children to read. We will be putting up a story every day from one of the Reception team or a link to another reader. Make sure you share a variety of stories with each other throughout the day. Also look at non-fiction books to find out about things like 'dinosaurs/cars/minibeasts/castles'. If you go for a walk during the day – see if you can read car signs/shop signs/number plates/logos etc.
