**Friends AGM** – I was delighted to attend The Friends' annual general meeting (AGM) last night via zoom. There were twenty parents present and it was fantastic to hear about how much was raised over this last year (£27,000!!) I am enormously grateful to the committee who will be staying in post for the next year. The next big event will be the Christmas Bazaar and lots will be asked of you in the coming weeks. The Friends will be sending out more information about their AGM meeting, so do please read it.

**Christmas Cards** – Your child should have come home with a Christmas card design which can be used to buy other merchandise such as mugs, tea towels, gift tags etc. All the orders must be made online – no orders or money are to be sent into school. **However, the deadline for any ordering is 16<sup>th</sup> November!** The Friends are trying to get an extension, but this may not be possible.

**Assemblies** – In the Catholic tradition, November is the month of the Holy Souls and so on Monday I led a remembrance assembly for people who have died. Today we held a two minute silence to remember those who have died in war. You are invited to write the names of any deceased relatives or friends in the book of remembrance at the front of school.

On Wednesday, Mrs Hindle led an assembly for the Junior children about St Martin de Porres, whose Saint's Day had been on 3<sup>rd</sup> November. She told the children about his early life and the discrimination he faced because of the colour of his skin. His traits were: being humble, compassionate, kind and caring to everyone. He had a particular love for animals. St Martin is patron saint of social justice, racial harmony and mixed race people.
