Assemblies - On Monday Mrs Roper spoke to the whole school about DLD (Developmental Language Disorder).

Today is actually DLD day, so if you are in Enfield today you will see the civic centre lit in purple to raise the awareness of DLD. There are 80 locations worldwide that will be lit up which you can access using the following link https://radld.org/dld-awareness-day/light-up-events/ (Apologies we had already chosen to mark showing racism the red card today, so couldn't really do both without diluting the racism issue.)

Developmental Language Disorder is a hidden but common disability that affects 1 in 14 people (2 children in every class,) causing difficulties understanding and using language for no known reason. The 2023 DLD day theme is *DLD Around the World*, highlighting that DLD occurs in every language.

On Tuesday Miss Nolan read the story "All things are difficult, before they are easy" by Thomas Fuller. A few interesting quotes she also read were "You have only failed if you have given up. Until then, it is learning." Also, "There is a difference between not knowing and not knowing yet" written by Sheila Tobias.

gOn Wednesday Mrs Warrington shared with the Junior children the importance of scientists. They looked at breaking stereotypes such as the white haired old man and realised that everyone in the room could be a scientist – who knows what they may go on to discover.
