In RE this half term...

Our topic is 'To the Ends of the Earth' and we will be learning about:

- What happened to the disciples at Pentecost
- The letter that St Paul wrote to the Galatians
- The Fruits of the Holy Spirit
- The conversion of Saul



In English...

Some children will continue to follow our Read Write Inc scheme. The children on our Power of Reading scheme, will explore re-telling, storytelling and poetry through our class texts. There will be a focus on children's ability to perform poems and compose their own poems using rhyme and rhythm.





We will be starting our new topic 'Plants' and Learning about the lifecycle of a plant

- Investigating the best conditions for plants to grow
- Comparing plant growth

PE this half term will be

- Outdoor PE: Hitting and Striking Indoor PE: Dance - Using dynamics to
- develop the dance

In Music...

We will be looking music reflecting our world.





Art...

In Art this half term, the children will experiment with how they can use the primary paint colours to make secondary paint colours. The children will explore how they can use different materials such as cotton buds to create a range of textures.

We will then discover the work of Romare Bearden and use this work to influence our own collage creations.

In RHE...

Children will be learning about 'Keeping Safe':

- Learning about secrets that are both safe/unsafe to keep
- Learning about harmful substances – smoking and alcohol

In Maths...

Length and Height

We will be:

- Measuring in centimetres (using a ruler) and metres (using a metre stick)
- Comparing and ordering lengths and heights using inequality symbols
- Applying four operations to work out length and heights

Mass, Capacity and Temperature We will be:

- Measuring in grams (g) and kilograms (kg)
- Comparing volume and capacity
- Measuring in millilitres (ml) and litres (l)
- Applying four operations to mass and
- Identifying and order temperatures

In the first couple of lessons of this half term, we will be finishing our learning about 'My Place, Your In History...

Our new topic is 'The Stone Age'. We will learn about how people survived in the Stone Age.
