How to help at home

Continue to encourage your child to read at home, both books from school and books, magazines, and news of their choice. Engage your child in conversation about what they are reading and their thoughts on the text. One of the things we do in Year 3 is to ask the children to justify their ideas. This could be asking how they know what is happening. Having conversations like this with your child would be very helpful developing these skills!
